

This tour in North Yorkshire offers a wealth of visits to country houses which display a variety of styles and rich contents. These reflect the age in which they were built, the architects who designed them and the taste and lifestyle of the owners.

MARKENFIELD, a 14th century moated house gives an insight into medieval life as does the magnificence of RABY CASTLE where 700 knights met in the Barons Hall in 1569. At NEWBY HALL we will lunch surrounded by one of the finest Robert Adam interiors in the neo-classical style to be found anywhere as well as Gobelin tapestries covering walls and furniture supplied by Thomas Chippendale.

CRATHORNE HALL is the luxurious hotel where the group will be based. It

was the former home of LORD CRATHORNE, President of The Georgian Group, who is joining our trip, and with its 115 rooms was the largest country house built in England in the Edwardian age. The itinerary offers a full programme of visits, including a reception and gala dinner at Lord Crathorne's present home. Most visits are private, often hosted by owners. PETER BROWN, Director of York Civic Trust, whose comprehensive knowledge of Yorkshire is invaluable, will be our guide throughout. This tour is fully inclusive with cost covering accommodation, all meals with wine, transport by luxury coach and entrance fees. There will also be a pre-tour champagne reception in London on Sunday evening, 11th October.



The tour starts Monday, October 12th, departing from central London and returning late afternoon Friday October 16th.

It includes accommodation throughout, all lunches and evening meals with wine, all visits and entrance charges and transport by luxury coach.

The fee for a double occupancy room is \$3940 per person, (plus \$360 single room supplement if required). A non-refundable deposit of \$800 secures a place with the remaining fee \$3140 pp. in double room, and \$3500 for a single room due by July 27th. Travel insurance is highly recommended.
